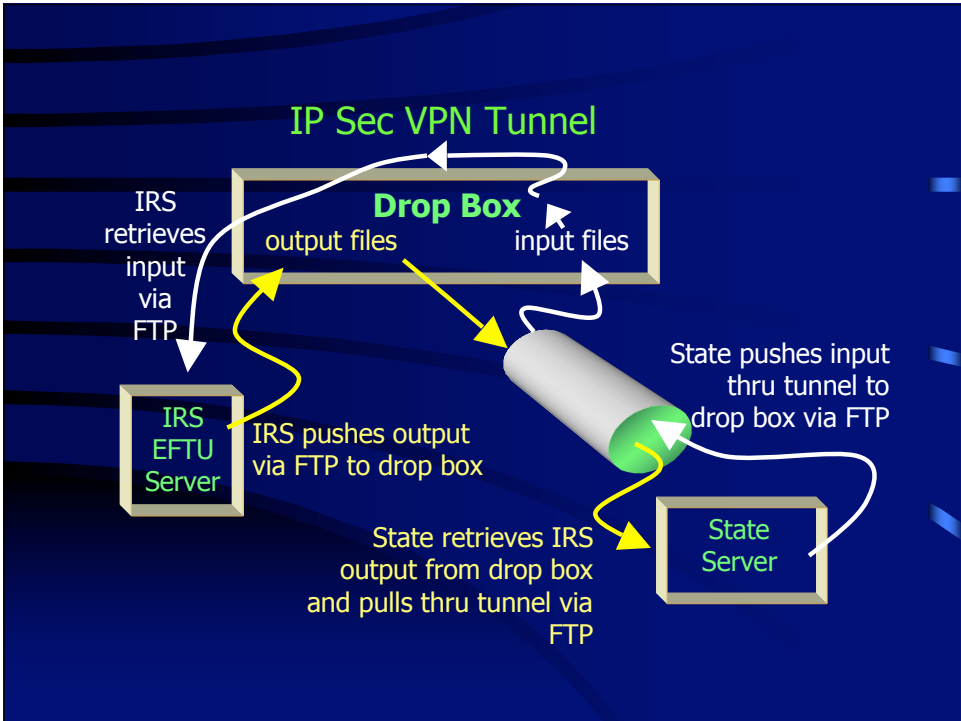
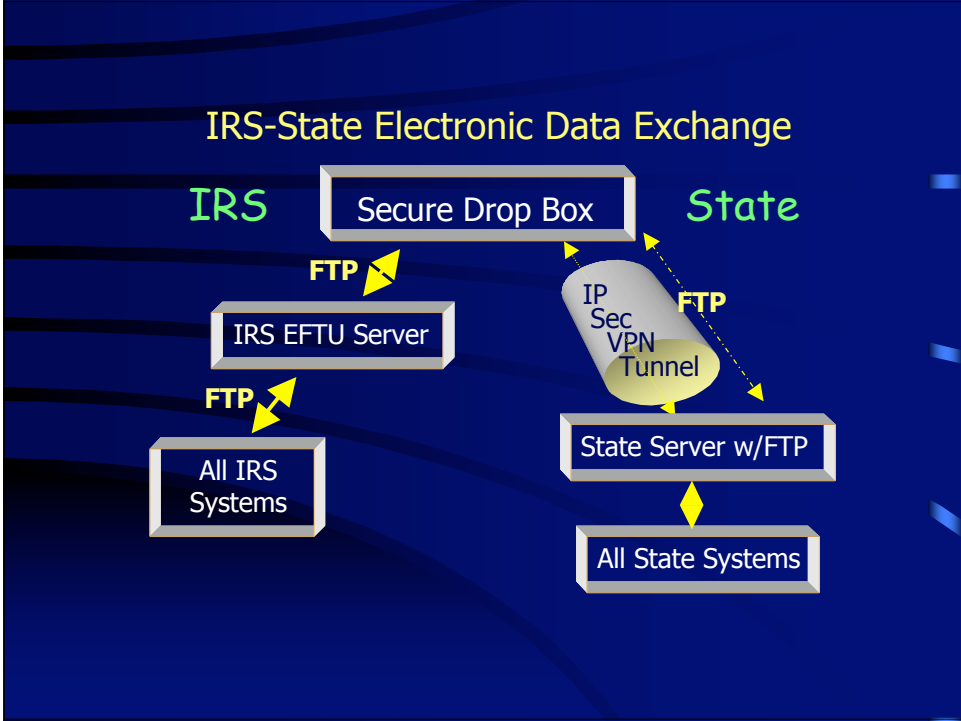

Goal of EDE

to develop and implement a system for the electronic distribution of GLDEP extracts to replace the use of magnetic media cartridges

System Description

- FTP using the Internet
- Virtual Private Network (VPN)
- Server to server connection
- only system approved (C&A) by IRS



State Responsibilities

- server w/FTP capability
- router
- communications software
- Interconnection Security Agreement (ISA)
- Safeguard Procedures Report (SPR)

State Responsibilities

- State completes portion of ISA
 - contact is local GL
- State must have a revised SPR approved by the IRS Safeguard Program Office
 - contact is IRS Safeguards office

Implementation Plan

- successful prototype completed
- 6-state pilot program
 - NYS-NJ-MA-DE-VA-CA
 - start with FEIN extract
- open to all GLDEP agencies upon completion of successful pilot

Implementation Plan

- mag tape will remain an option
- plan is for all GLDEP extracts
 - system capacity concerns with larger extracts
- only for GLDEP extracts at this time
