# Fuel Tax Council Update

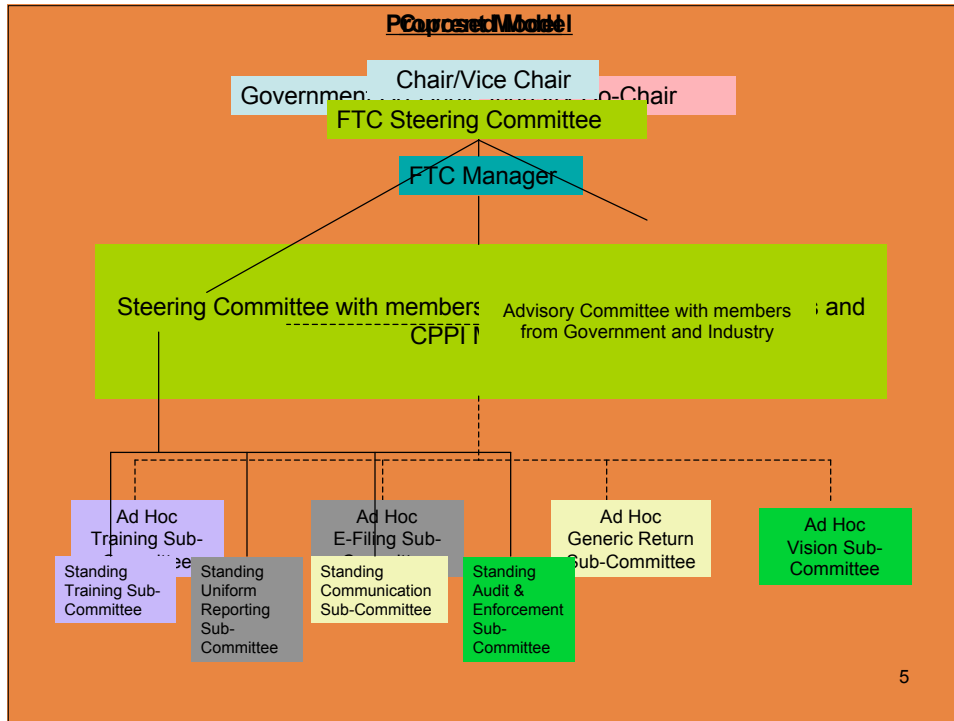
## **VISION**
