Safeguard Workshop March 31 - April 2, 2008, St. Louis

Computer Security Workshop April 2-3, 2008, St. Louis

To State Tax Administrators:

FTA is partnering with the IRS to hold a two related workshops the first week in April in St. Louis. The first workshop will be on general Safeguarding issues, particularly addressing updates to the requirements listed in the IRS Pub. 1075, while the second will focus on Computer Security for protecting federal tax return information.

The two workshops will run back-to-back for the convenience of those attendees who wish to participate in both.

The meetings are designed for state disclosure officers, information technology staff and others responsible for the use and safeguarding of federal tax return information. A draft agenda will be released by the end of January. Presentations will primarily be made by the IRS staff from Mission Assurance, which has responsibility for all safeguard reviews and all other matters relating to the physical and computer and security of IRS data. We are also planning some presentations by state tax personnel who will discuss their experiences and lessons learned.

Program

The Safeguarding Workshop will begin with registration on Monday morning; the sessions will begin at approximately 12:30 p.m. on Monday, March 31, and will end at approximately noon on Wednesday, April 2. There will be a get-together reception on Monday evening.

The Computer Security workshop will begin with registration on Wednesday morning, April 2. Training will begin at approximately 12:30 p.m. on Wednesday; it will end at 5 p.m. on Thursday. This workshop will enjoy a get-together reception on Wednesday evening.

Please note there will be a side meeting of the Security Subcommittee of the FTA Tactical Advisory Group (TAG) on Friday April 4 from 8:30 a.m. until noon. Non-members are welcome to attend this meeting.

Logistics

A block of rooms has been set aside for the nights of March 30 (limited rooms available), March 31, April 1, April 2 and April 3 at the Sheraton St. Louis City Center. You should make your reservations directly with the hotel by calling at 314-231-5007 or 1-888-627-8096. **(Note: IRS personnel who will be attending either meeting, whether as presenters or attendees, will reserve their rooms as a group; you should confirm your need for a room with Sammi.Shultz@irs.gov.)**

The rate is \$129 for a single or double plus tax, which currently is 14.991 percent. Ask for the Federation of Tax Administrators' room block when making your reservations. **The deadline for hotel reservations is March 9, and we strongly urge you to make reservations before the deadline.** Our meeting occurs during the opening week of baseball season and downtown housing outside of the room block may be tight.

Registration

The meeting registration fee of \$320 **for each workshop** includes a light reception for each workshop, one luncheon for each workshop and a continental breakfast each morning. A registration form is attached for each workshop; if you will be attending both workshops, please register for each separately.
