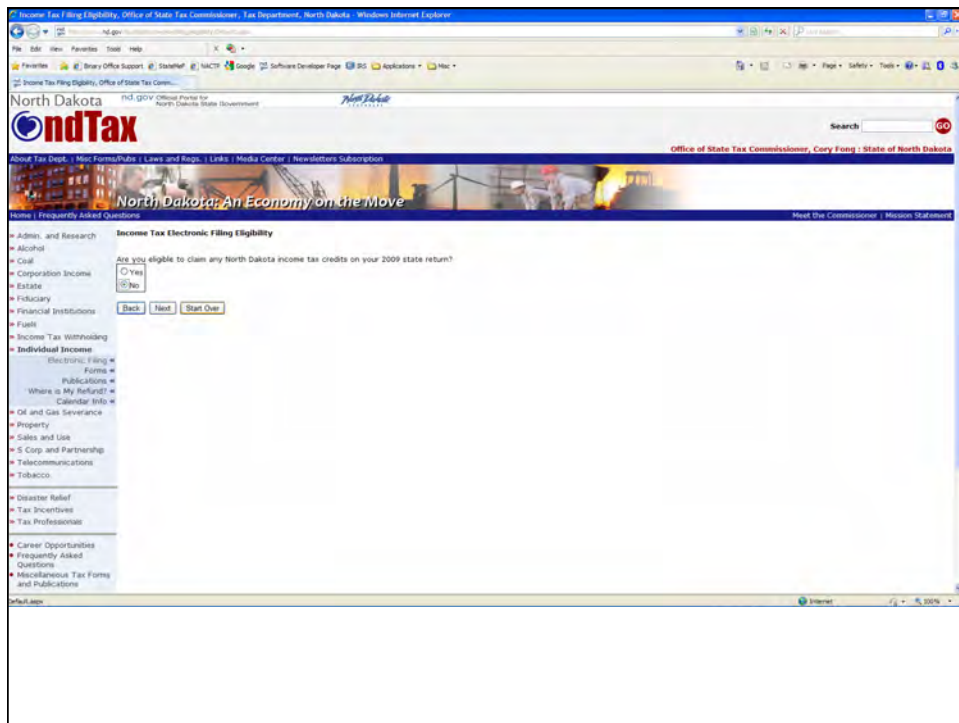
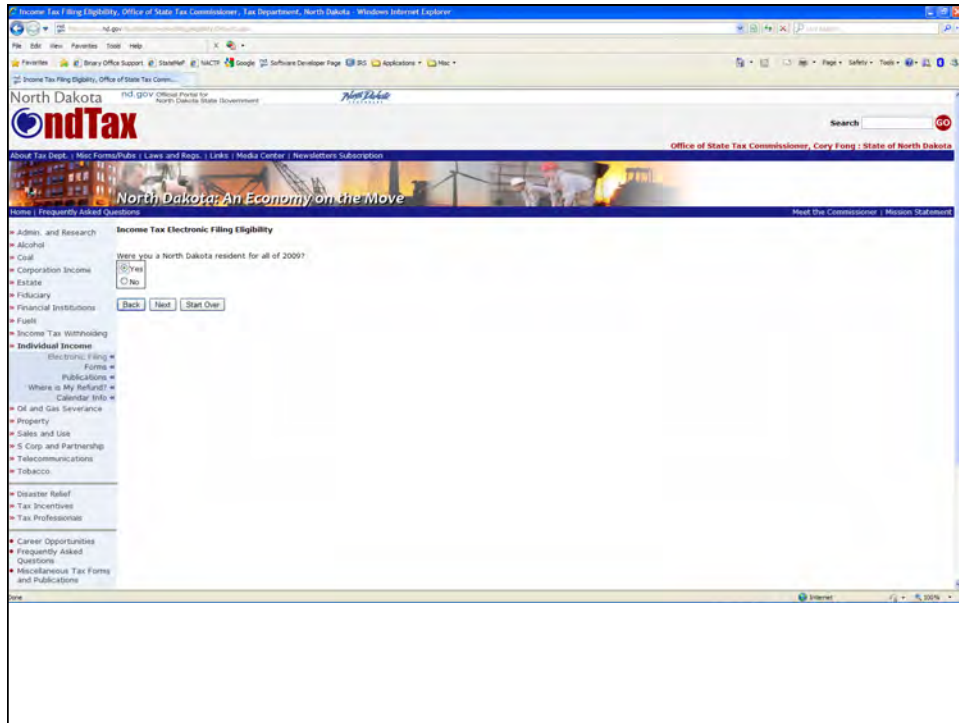
If you have any questions or problems with an electronic service provider's website, including error messages received while attempting to use their services, you must contact that service provider's customer service for help.

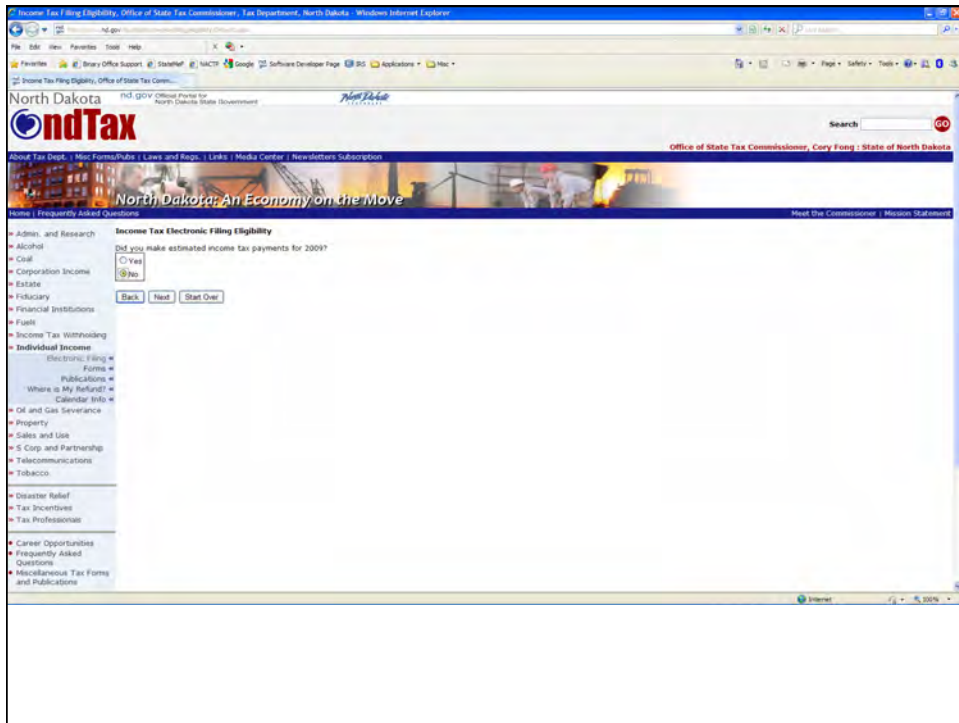
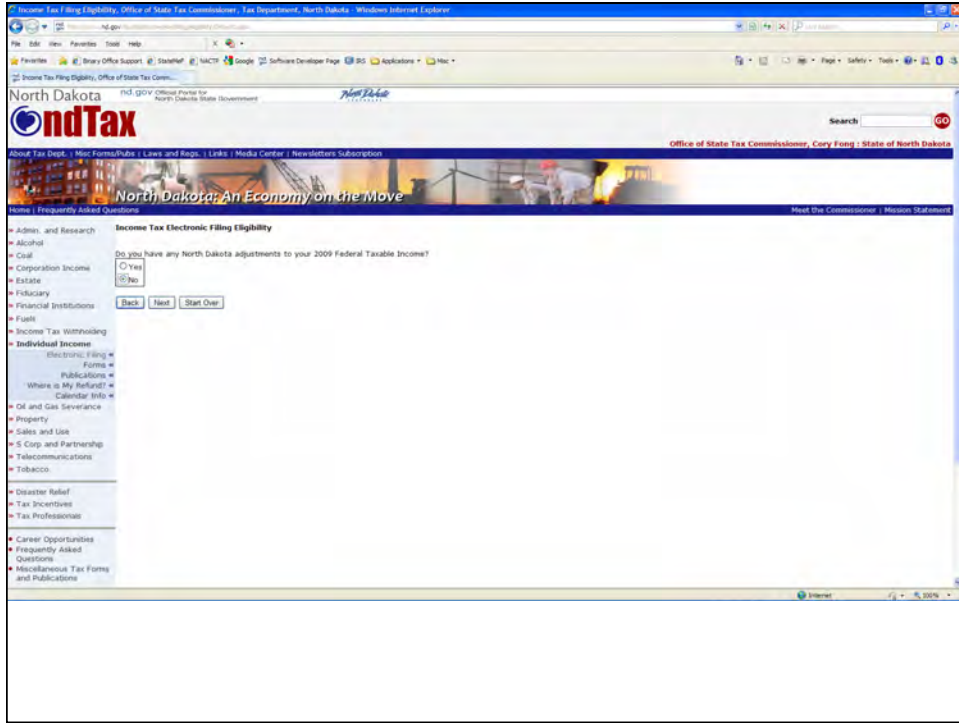

Errors will appear in red fields or a message may display when you move your cursor over an Error field.", "If your return shows a tax refund due, your refund will be issued by check and mailed to the North Dakota address entered on the WebFile program.", "In some cases, it may be necessary to turn off your browser's pop-up blocker for all features of the WebFile program to work correctly.", "Do not submit your return more than once through the WebFile program. If you need to make changes, you will need to file an amended paper return.", "If you experience difficulties using the WebFile program, the problem may be with your Internet Options. Our WebFile program was designed to use these browsers.", "A "Continue" button is located at the bottom right of the text area.
