**The Department conducts basic sales and use tax seminars in Spanish at various locations throughout the state.**

**A Spanish version of basic sales and use tax powerpoint presentation is used in this venue, and a hard copy is provided to attendees.**



**The Department has three bi-lingual employees who provide:**

**taxpayer assistance in Spanish for walk-in customers in our Lincoln, Omaha and Scottsbluff offices;**

**taxpayer assistance in Spanish for phone customers.**



The breakdown of time spent working with Spanish-speaking individuals is as follows:

**During tax season:**

**Lincoln – 40%**

**Omaha – 15%**

**Scottsbluff – 10%**

**During the off season:**

**Lincoln – 10%**

**Omaha – 7%**

**Scottsbluff – 4%.**
